

The Regulatory Authority of Bermuda invites applications for the role of **COUNSEL TO THE BOARD / HEAD OF LEGAL FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS**. Reporting to the Chief Executive, this position will be responsible for Board legal advice and initiatives, as well as directly involved in complex legal and regulatory assessment with regards to telecommunications sectoral participants/companies.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide legal counsel to the Board and Commissioners as requested, maintaining Board records and ensuring public disclosure in accordance with legislation
- Leads on all legal deliverables for the regulation of the telecommunications sector
- Works closely with Chief Executive and Management team to facilitate a cohesive and integrated approach in the Authority's operations and ultimate fulfilment of the strategic objectives of the organisation.
- Maintain Regulatory Authority compliance with relevant Bermuda law.
- Facilitate and administer the development and implementation of framework for relative legal documentation pertaining to telecommunications regulatory consultations, orders, decisions etc.
- Provide strategic legal advice on sectoral regulation.
- Conduct legal and regulatory research as required.
- Administer the effective drafting, implementation and enforcement of policies and procedures as directed.
- Advises on the effective implementation and enforcement of competition law in the sector.
- Provides legal advice on decisions, strategy, consultative papers, position papers and any other matter requiring legal vetting or interpretation.

Minimum Qualifications, Experience and Skills:

- Law degree and active member of Bermuda Bar Association
- Board level experience as legal counsel and advisor to the Board.
- Professional corporate secretarial qualifications.
- Strong analytical, interpersonal and communication skills (both written and oral), research capabilities, resourcefulness and creative abilities; and
- Proficiency in the use of office automation tools, particularly Microsoft.
- Ability to work as a member of a team.
- A working knowledge of Bermuda's administrative, employment and criminal law, law of evidence and law of contract.
