Dear Sirs,

We write pursuant to Section 73(2) of the Regulatory Authority Act 2011 (the "RAA") following 20 and 21 March 2018 telephone conversations between counsel for Bermuda Electric Light Company Limited ("BELCO"), Lakilah Spencer, and the Regulatory Authority's (the "Authority") Head of Regulatory Finance, Jozelle Escolastica (the "Calls").

The Calls followed a prior conversation between BELCO and Ms. Escolastica, which is summarized in the attached copy of a letter to the Authority dated 15 March 2018, during which BELCO requested that the deadline for filing responses to the ongoing retail tariffs consultation be extended to 19 April 2018 (the "Request"). On 20 March 2018, Ms. Spencer placed a follow-up call to enquire about the status of the Request, and on 21 March 2018, Ms. Escolastica contacted Ms. Spencer to advise that the Authority would extend the deadline for responses.

Dear Sirs,

We write pursuant to Section 73(2) of the Regulatory Authority Act 2011 (the "RAA") following the 13 March 2018 telephone conversation between counsel for Bermuda Electric Light Company Limited ("BELCO"), Lorianne Gilbert and Lakilah Spencer (together, "Counsel"), and the Regulatory Authority's (the "Authority") Head of Regulatory Finance, Jozelle Escolastica (the "Call").

Following the Authority's publication of the Retail Tariffs Design Public Consultation dated 8 March 2018 (the "Consultation"), Counsel placed the Call to request that the deadline for filing responses to the Consultation be extended past 29 March 2018. It was explained that, given the importance of the issue being considered in the Consultation, the original consultation period of three (3) weeks was too short to enable a considered response from the public. For example, the consultation period would not provide BELCO sufficient time to consult the necessary external experts that would assist with the preparation of BELCO's response. Counsel communicated a suggested revised deadline of 19 April 2018, as such a date would provide BELCO and members of the public with six weeks in which to respond to the Consultation.

Ms. Escolastica advised that she would revert with a response in due course.
