

Feed-In Tariff Methodology Public Consultation Ex Parte Communication

In the matter of the Regulatory Authority Act, 2016 (the “**RAA**”), and in accordance with section 73(4)(a) of the RAA, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following party has engaged the Regulatory Authority of Bermuda (the “**Authority**”) in *ex parte* communications in connection with the 1st Round Public Consultation document on the development of the Feed-In Tariff Methodology (the “**Consultation Document**”) published on the 27th April 2018 (the “**Consultation Date**”), pursuant to section 36 of the Electricity Act 2016 (the “**EA**”).
