**Request for Grant of Spectrum License 3.65-3.70GHz
Proposed ECL *AirMax* Private Data Service**

We would be pleased for the Regulatory Authority to consider the granting of the 3.65GHz spectrum to ECL for use in our existing Private Data Service offering. This letter and the attached Annexes provide the supporting details and reasons for selection of the band concerned.

ECL has been delivering private data services for several years. Initial services used equipments in the ISM band, with the first deployment delivering bulk carrier's carrier service. Over several years the ISM band has become heavily populated with non-carrier radiators and consequently, commercial service offerings using this spectrum have reduced in popularity and are now best made in licensed bands.

ECL has been approached recently for urgent request for service for private data services in Hamilton and beyond. Several potential customers are seeking alternate / diverse routing for inter office VPN links. . A scan of the available bands revealed that a small fraction of FCC band plan spectrum is available in the 3.65 band. This application seeks use of this band, specifically in the 3.65-3.70 GHz range to deliver our enhanced service.
