

Retail Tariff Design Public Consultation Ex Parte Communication

In the matter of the Regulatory Authority Act, 2016 (the “**RAA**”), and in accordance with section 73(4)(a) of the RAA, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following parties have engaged the Regulatory Authority (the “**Authority**”) in *ex parte* communications in connection with the 1st Round Public Consultation document on the development of the Feed-In Tariff Methodology (the “**Consultation Document**”) published on the 27th April 2018 (the “**Consultation Date**”), pursuant to section 36 of the Electricity Act 2016 (the “**EA**”).

Since the Consultation Date, the Authority has entered into the following *ex parte* communications with the Bermuda Electric Light Company Limited (“**BELCO**”) and David Kendall (“**Mr. Kendall**”):

Ex parte communication with Mr. Kendall.

- 8th May 2018:
 - The Authority responded to Mr. Kendall’s query and also communicated the reporting obligations specified under section 73(4) of the RAA which requires the Authority to post a notice of the *ex parte* communication on the Authority’s website.
- 1st May 2018:
 - Mr. Kendall submitted an e-mail containing a written summary of his issues concerning the Consultation Document.

Ex parte communication with legal counsel for BELCO.

- 8th May 2018:
 - BELCO submitted a letter dated 8th May 2017 to the Authority to clarify that the period within which to respond to the Consultation Document has been extended to 28th May 2018.
- 4th May 2018:
 - The Authority responded to BELCO’s query and noted that the deadline to respond to the Consultation Document has been extended to 28th May 2018.
- 3rd May 2018:
 - Legal counsel for BELCO submitted an e-mail message to the Authority containing a written summary of its issues concerning the deadline to submit responses to the Consultation Document.
