GOVERNMENT FEES AMENDMENT (NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2017

BR 31 / 2017

The Minister of Finance, in exercise of the power conferred by section 2 of the Government Fees Act 1965, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These regulations, which amend the Government Fees Regulations 1976 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Government Fees Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 2017.

Inserts Head 23A

2 The Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by inserting after Head 23 the following—

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(1)	Authorisation to a TD&R Licence holder to provide electricity transmission, distribution and retail services	\$0.20 per megawatt-hour sold (payable quarterly, in arrears)
(2)	Authorisation to a Bulk Generation Licence holder to engage in Utility Scale Electricity Generation (greater than 25 megawatts of installed electricity generation capacity)	\$485 per megawatt per annum of installed electricity generation capacity (payable quarterly)
(3)	Authorisation to a Bulk Generation Licence holder to engage in Fossil Fuel Bulk Electricity Generation	\$800 per megawatt per annum of

(greater than 0.5 megawatts but less than 25 megawatts of installed electricity generation capacity)	installed electricity generation capacity (payable quarterly)
(4) Authorisation to a Bulk Generation Licence holder to engage in Waste-to-Energy Bulk Electricity Generation (greater than 0.5 megawatts but less than 25 megawatts of installed electricity generation capacity)	\$0
(5) Authorisation to a Bulk Generation Licence holder to engage in Renewable Energy Bulk Electricity Generation (greater than 0.5 megawatts but less than 25 megawatts of installed electricity generation capacity)	\$800 per megawatt per annum of installed electricity generation capacity (payable quarterly) ”.
