REGULATORY AUTHORITY AMENDMENT ACT 2014

2014 : 1

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Regulatory Authority Act 2011;

Be it enacted by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Assembly of Bermuda, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Citation

1 This Act, which amends the Regulatory Authority Act 2011 ("the principal Act") may be cited as the Regulatory Authority Amendment Act 2014.

Amends section 62

2 Section 62 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) in subsection (2)(a) by inserting, after the word "shall", the words ", subject to section 66,";
- (b) in subsection (3)(b) by inserting, before the word "cause", the words "subject to subsection (3A),"; and
- (c) by inserting, after subsection (3)—

"(3A) A Schedule to a general determination made in accordance with this section is not required to be included in the publication in the Gazette under subsection (3)(b) if—

- (a) the Schedule is published on the Authority's official website;
- (b) the Schedule is available for inspection at the offices of the Authority; and
- (c) the general determination gives notice that the Schedule—

- (i) is published on the Authority’s official website; and
- (ii) is available for inspection at the offices of the Authority.”.

Amends section 66

3 Section 66 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (6)—

“(6A) For the avoidance of doubt, a Schedule to a general determination is not required to be included in a publication pursuant to this section, whether in the Gazette or in a newspaper, if—

- (a) the Schedule is published on the Authority’s official website;
- (b) the Schedule is available for inspection at the offices of the Authority; and
- (c) the general determination gives notice that the Schedule—
 - (i) is published on the Authority’s official website; and
 - (ii) is available for inspection at the offices of the Authority.”.

Amends section 67

4 Section 67(2) of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words “A general” and substituting the words “Subject to section 66(4), a general”.
