TELECOMMUNICATIONS (DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS' PRISONS
TELEPHONE SYSTEM) (EXEMPTION) ORDER 2011

The Minister responsible for Telecommunications, in exercise of the power conferred by section 66 of the Telecommunications Act 1986, makes the following Order:

Citation

1 This Order may be cited as the Telecommunications (Department of Corrections' Prisons Telephone System) (Exemption) Order 2011.

Exemption from the licence requirement in section 9(1) of the Telecommunications Act 1986

2 The Department of Corrections is exempted from the licence requirement in section 9(1) of the Telecommunications Act 1986 for the purposes of establishing, maintaining or operating a public telecommunications service, namely a Prisons Telephone System, at the Department of Corrections' facilities with the following conditions—

- (a) such service shall only be provided to inmates of the Department of Corrections' facilities; and
- (b) any fee, or variation of fee, related to the provision of this service must be submitted to and approved by the Telecommunications Commission prior to introduction.

Strict interpretation

3 Nothing in this Order shall be interpreted as exempting the Department of Corrections from any provision of the Telecommunications Act 1986 or any Regulations made under that Act, not expressly referred to in paragraph 2.
